# 1948

### 1950's

Before long, the church outgrew the Willem's living room and began looking for a new space to call home. Space was rented in an unlikely place: a local tavern!



### 1963

Neighborhood Church moved into its new home at the intersection of Walnut and County Center our home for over three decades.



### 1997

17 acres of pasture were purchased at \$25,000 per acre. The Neighborhood family pledges \$1.5 million to build our current campus.



### 2006

We adopted Houston School in 2006 as a way to be FOR our city and make an impact through real relationships. This evetually led to the construction of Houston Neighborhood Park.



### 2017

In 2017 we kicked off our FOR Visalia campaign to fund a massive renovation to our campus—primarily to expand space for kids!

We are FOR Visalia—that means our entire city. By partnering with Jesus and each other, we work to make Visalia a better place for everyone, regardless of what they believe.








At Neighborhood, we want to make an impact at home, in our city, and across the world. That's why we're partnering with Students International to build a community center in Costa Rica.






After purchasing property in 2018, SI is planning on building a central hub to tangibly transform the lives of locals and participants on short-term missions teams.
